- Group 1 : **108** fish landed
- Group 2 : **177** fish landed
- Group 3 : **135** fish landed
- Group 4 : **111** fish landed
- Group 5: **79** fish landed
- Biggest Tiger : **12.5 lbs** (5.67kg)
- Biggest Nembwe : **8 lbs** (3.63kg)
- Most fish in one day: **54**
- Most fish by one boat in one day: **23**


