Activities

At Mutemwa, adventure runs deeper than the river. As a family-run lodge with over 30 years on the Upper Zambezi, we've made it our joy to share this wild and beautiful place with our guests - who quickly become part of the story. Whether you're reeling in your first ever Tigerfish, exploring the bush on foot, or visiting the mighty Ngonye Falls, each experience is personal, unforgettable, and rooted in the natural rhythm of the Zambezi.

EXPERIENCES AT MUTEMWA:

- **Unlimited Tiger Fishing** – Explore 90 km of virtually private river, guided by our seasoned local experts
- **Exceptional Birding** – Spot hundreds of species along the riverbanks and floodplains year-round
- **Boma Dining** - Enjoy our open air boma through a personally hosted 3 course bush dinner every night.
- **Bush Walks** – Immerse yourself in the natural beauty and quiet of our Zambezi surroundings
- **Fish Eagle Feeding Experience** – Witness Africa's iconic raptor up close as it swoops for a meal
- **Ngonye Falls Excursion** – Visit the thundering Ngonye Falls, one of Zambia's hidden natural wonders and second largest waterfall on the Zambezi
- **Sioma Ngwezi Game Drives*** – Explore the nearby Sioma Ngwezi National Park on a guided safari

Our Gear

We believe that great fishing starts with great gear. At Mutemwa, we've carefully selected high-quality tackle, rods, and equipment tailored to the unique demands of tiger fishing on the Upper Zambezi.

OUR BOATS

We fish the Zambezi with four 6.0m x 1.8m custom-designed aluminium Swamp Cruisers — built specifically for tiger fishing on this mighty river. Each boat offers two stable casting platforms (front and back), a central bench for cruising, and two comfortable trolling seats for long sessions on the water. Powered by a reliable 70HP Yamaha four-stroke engine, our boats deliver a smooth, powerful and quiet performance perfectly suited to the Zambezi. Ideal for 2 guests per boat, but easily accommodates 3 if needed.

GEAR & TACKLE

Each boat is fully equipped with the following setups.

For trolling:

- Reel: Shimano Socorro SW5000
- Rod: Medium heavy 5'6" 8-12kg 1-piece

For Spinning:

- Reel: Shimano Sedona C5000XG
- Rod: Shimano Nexave Tiger 7'0" 15-30 lb 2-piece

NOTE: Any lost, damaged, or broken tackle will be charged to the guests account.



Dining

As the sun dips behind the Zambezi and the hippos begin to grunt, the golden light and glowing lanterns welcome you to the heart of Mutemwa — our open-air boma.

Here, every evening becomes an occasion.

Set around the fire and under the stars, one of our chefs announces dinner and the starters are served. These are followed by a generous main course buffet, and then a plated dessert to close off the evening in style. Hosted personally by the Johnson family, dinner at Mutemwa is a gathering of stories, laughter, and connection — this is where our guests become family.

The colonial charm, open setting, and heart felt “Zambezi feeling” are all wrapped into one for unforgettable nights around the Mutemwa Boma.





What to Pack

Packing for Mutemwa is all about comfort and practicality. Whether you're out on the river, relaxing by the pool, or exploring the bush, here are a few essentials to bring along for a comfortable and enjoyable stay:

- A good pair of walking shoes and socks
- Sandals for around the lodge and in your tent
- Long sleeve and mid-sleeve cotton shirts
- Breathable long-sleeved fishing shirts
- Shorts for midday wear
- Swimming costume
- A wind breaker
- A lightweight rain jacket for the rainy season
- A wide brimmed hat and a cap
- Sunglasses
- High SPF sunblock and mosquito repellent
- Camera, video camera, binoculars, spare memory cards, and chargers

- A warm jacket
- Thermal undergarments
- Winter evening wear
- A beanie and scarf for early mornings on the river
- A few long sleeve shirts

TRAVEL BY AIR

Kasane - Rd transfer (~3hrs)

Fly into Botswana's Kasane Airport (BBK) and take a road transfer to the Katima Mulilo border where we will collect you from there for a short, 50km transfer to Mutemwa. SA Airlink fly daily to Kasane Airport (BBK) and bookings can be made directly online. Approximate travel time accommodates for border crossings.

Charter Flight (~45min)

Fly into Livingstone International Airport, then enjoy a seamless private charter directly to our Mutemwa airstrip — where we'll be waiting to welcome you with ice-cold drinks and a warm smile.

Road transfers and charter flights can be arranged by Mutemwa.

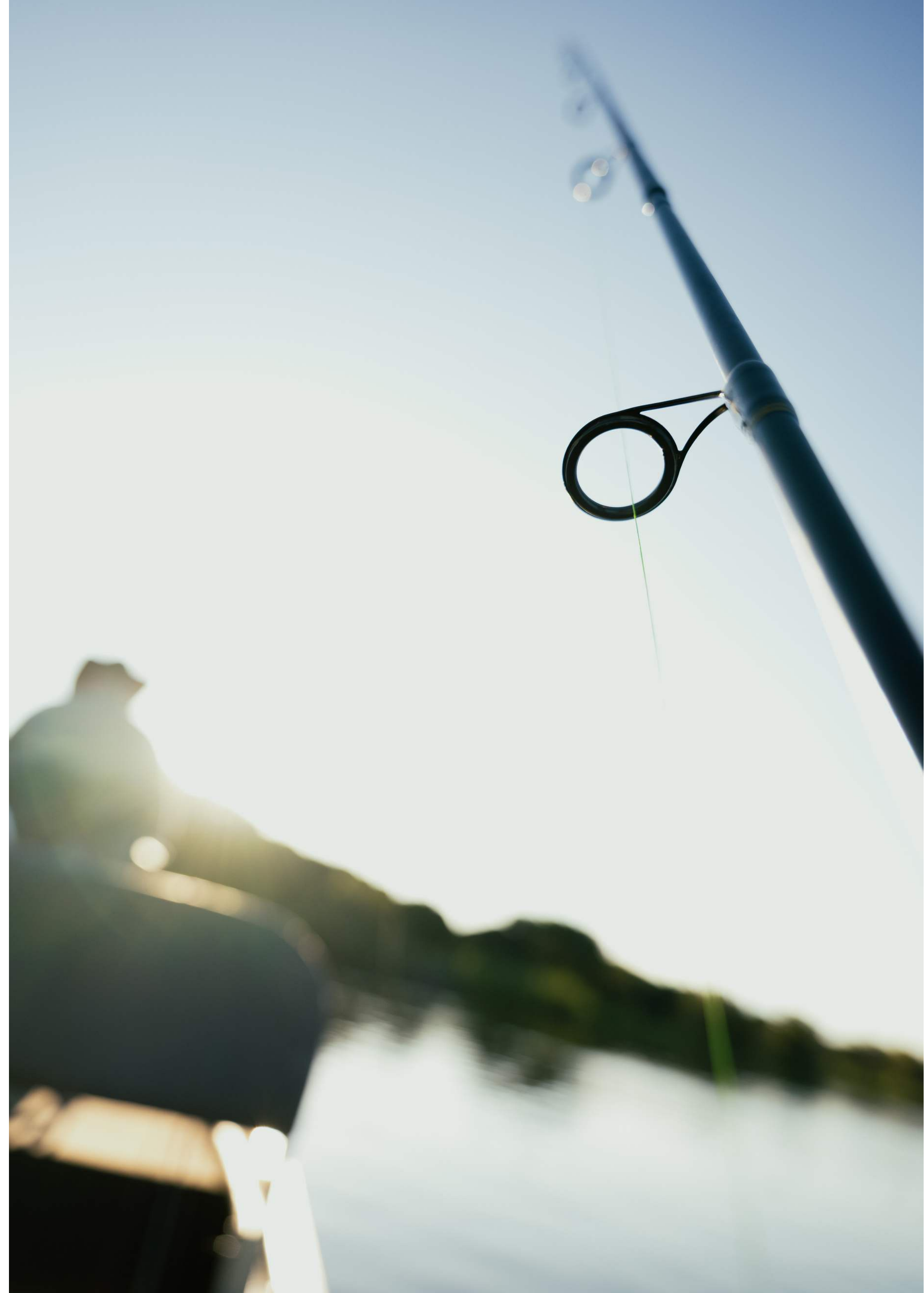

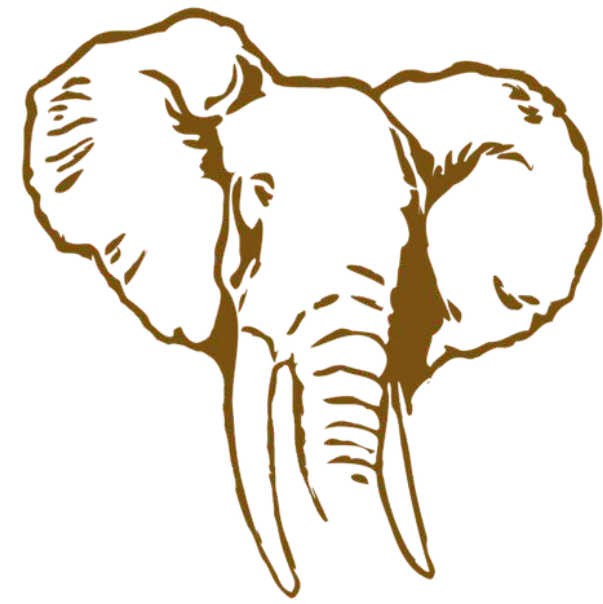

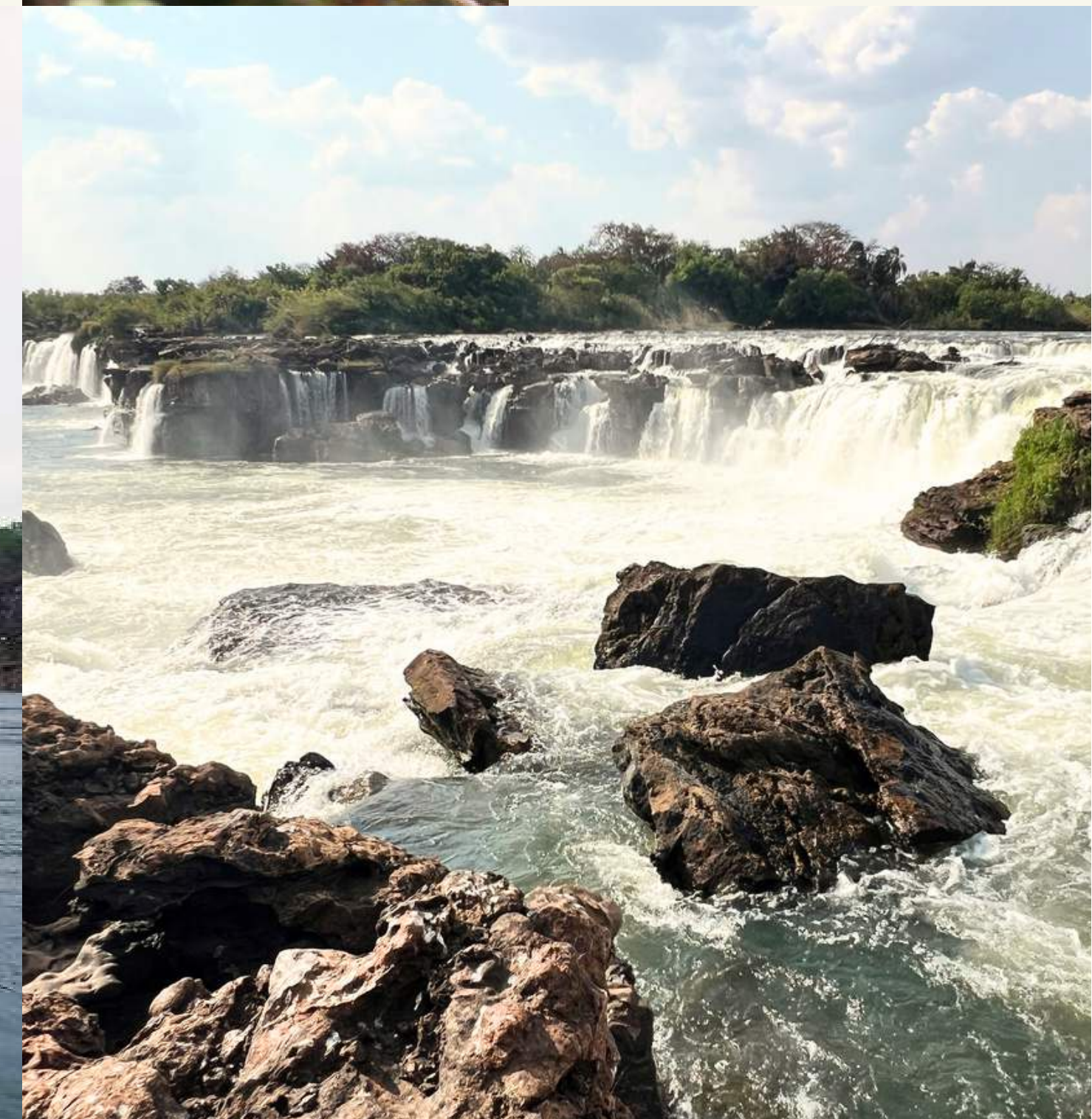
